

The CADE SAUVIGNON BLANC 2019 from Napa Valley has been chosen for Wine Of the Month for June. This very fine upper end Sauvignon Blanc from CADE'S Howell Mountain 54 acre vineyard sits well above the fog line and is owned by the same team as the fabulous Napa Floor winery PLUMPJACK. With aromas of orange blossom, lemon-lime, and apple together with some grapefruit and pineapple notes, this food friendly wine finishes with a palate of tangerine, peach, and minerality that concludes with good acidity and creamy textures due to its blend of French oak and stainless steel fermentation and aging. Always rated in the 90's, try this fine wine chilled with all chicken and shell fish, (shrimp and crab best), pork, and just by itself! At \$9.00 per glass in JUNE. ABOUT JIM "MOOSE" BROWN

Jim "Moose" Brown has had a very diverse career, playing on over 25 #1 country singles and recording with a wide range of artists as a session musician. He won the Academy of Country Music Award for Piano/Keyboard player of the Year in 2015 and 2017. Moose tours and records with Bob Seger and is a member of the Silver Bullet Band.

As a songwriter Moose won the Grammy award for Best Country Song for co-writing "It's Five O'clock Somewhere", and he has had songs recorded by Martina McBride, Jamey Johnson, John Schneider, Tyler Farr, Darryl Worley, David Allen Coe, James Otto, Julie Roberts, Ronnie Milsap, Joe Nichols, and others.

As a record producer Moose co-produced Daryl Worley's top 10 single "Sounds Like Life To Me" as well as the critically acclaimed album by Jamey Johnson "That Lonesome Song" which features the ACM and CMA Song of the Year "In Color". The Platinum selling album was nominated at the Grammys, ACMs and CMAs for Album of the Year. Moose also co-produced Jamey's certified Gold double album "The Guitar Song", which was also Grammy nominated for best country album. Moose played on the movie soundtracks of "Varsity Blues", "Country Strong", "Cars, and Cars 2".





ABOUT DON SAMPSON



Don Sampson was born in Washington, D.C. and grew up in Falls Church, VA. When Don was 22 years old, he moved to Nashville from San Antonio, TX, where he had been playing guitar in the honkytonks. Don signed his first publishing deal in 1985.

His songwriting credits include the #1 singles Brad Paisley's "Waitin' On A Woman," Gary Allan's "Tough Little Boys," Alan Jackson's "Midnight in Montgomery," and Bryan White's "Rebecca Lynn." "Waitin' On A Woman" also received the NSAI Song Of The Year honor in 2009. Don has won numerous ASCAP awards, seven NSAI awards, and the TNN Music City News Songwriters Award.

Other artists that have recorded Don's songs include Darius Rucker, Josh Thompson, Jimmy Wayne, George Jones, Tammy Wynette, Willie Nelson, Kenny Rogers, Brad Paisley, Kenny Chesney, Josh Turner, Tim McGraw, Charlie Daniels, John Conlee, Joe Nichols, and Charlie Pride.
