WINE AND FOOD THOUGHTS FROM OUR CELLAR MASTER

Tom Storey

I have been asked to write an article for the Old Waverly Newsletter on Wine and Food at Old Waverly. This is my inaugural epistle, the subject of which is the prominent Caymus wine family of the “Wagners” of California wine Country.

Caymus was founded by Charlie and Lorna Wagner in 1972. Caymus wines have been for several years among the top 5 or 10 most famous Cabernet Sauvignons of all Napa Valley and indeed in all the West Coast Wine Country. Old Waverly will continue to have these great wines from time to time when we can find them from our limited allocations.

Caymus remains a family winery today under their son Chuck Wagner and Chuck’s children Jenny Wagner and Joe Wagner. Joe has branched out on his own, making world class single vineyard Pinot Noir under the Belle Glos label. Old Waverly from time to time features the very high end and complex Caymus Select and Caymus Cabernet Sauvignon as well as three of the Belle Glos single vineyard Pinot Noirs: Dairyman, Clarke & Telephone, and Alturas. Recently, Joe has ventured out with a world class single vineyard Chardonnay, Glasir Holt from Sana Barbara County, Sta. Rita Hills AVA, a wine full of crisp apple and medium minerality, already winning great acclaim. Daddy, Chuck Wagner II, Chuck’s grandson, is the Director of winemaking for the unique Napa Valley white blend, Conundrum, a blend of Muscat, Chardonnay, and Sauvignon Blanc, pretty well invented from mixing the wine grapes at grandpa Charlie Wagner’s dinner table! Chuck’s Mer Soleil Winery in the Santa Lucia Highlands in Monterey County make world class Chardonnays, one a “Gold Label” that packs a lot of oak and butter, and the other, a “Silver Label” completely unoaked with rich minerality and citrus fruits. A new wine, the Reserve Pinot Noir, is gaining high ratings from Mer Soliel. Chuck’s daughter, Jenny Wagner, is the winemaker and boss at the fabulous Napa Valley Emmolo Winery making beautiful Sauvignon Blanc and a fine luscious big Merlot. Named for Jenny’s mother’s side of her family. The Sauvignon Blanc is world class with rich fruit and moderate acidity and is my daughter’s favorite! I really like it too.

As you can see the name “Wagner” means one thing: HIGH QUALITY WINES that you can enjoy as a fabulous wine experience. The Wagner’s are the Mondavi family of the 21st Century California.

These are not all the wines the Wagner’s produce as this Family continues to introduce new wines, and they lead the industry by innovating new viticulture and winemaking techniques in California!

I will continue to share my Thoughts on Wine and Food at Old Waverly in future months. Any comments or suggestions from members will be very welcome!

WINE OF THE MONTH FOR SEPTEMBER: ROMBAUER CHARDONNAY 2021 (Carneros). I have selected this rich Chardonnay from the cool Carneros AVA receives Coastal winds from the San Pablo Bay north of San Francisco. Rombauer was founded in 1980 by Koerner and Joan Rombauer and remains today as a family-owned winery. Aged in American and French Oak barrels, this beautiful wine is ripe with yellow pear, baked apple and spicy nectarine flavors finishing with lively acidity and butter. Best to be drunk warmer around 62 degrees; matches perfectly with most seafood and shellfish, especially with a white sauce, baked chicken, pastas. Perfect with Lobster too! Highly recommended for your September enjoyment at only a reduced price of \$55 per bottle. Tom Storey Cellar Master

WINE OF THE MONTH FOR OCTOBER: EARTHQUAKE ZINFANDEL 2018 (Lodi) As fall rolls in, Family founded, and still owned, Michael and David Winery brings us a burly, big, and spicy Zinfandel that packs a wallop with blackberry and blueberry fruit married with some dark chocolate finishing on the palate with some cocoa and cola flavors. A must with pork ribs and chicken BBQ, most grilled meats, red tomato pastas, and seasoned steaks. This big and rich wine is no weakling and that is why it was named after the 1906 San Francisco Earthquake! Lodi is Zin Country and Michael and David is a premiere winery in Lodi. Great for Halloween, too! Only \$40 per bottle in October! Boo! Tom Storey, Cellar Master
