Eastern Bluebird



Mr. Jerry Ishee is one of Old Waverly's best "SEASONAL EMPLOYEES". Spring is his thing. You may have seen him driving around on his golf cart checking on the Bluebird Boxes. Yes, Bluebird Boxes. Since 2008 Mr. Ishee has been doing more than his part to build the Eastern Bluebird population that at one point was headed for extinction.

From late February to late August, hours are spent racing from Bluebird Box to Bluebird Box with his Record Books meticulously kept over the years. His notes show the numbers of eggs, numbers of hatches, numbers of flys and a lot more!

Today Old Waverly has 45 homes for Eastern Bluebirds and Mossy Oak has 15. Since Mr. Ishee has been recording his findings, he shows 4300 "flys"




from his boxes at Old Waverly. That means 4300 Eastern Bluebirds were a success story; born, raised and flew the coup of their Waverly homes. Mr. Ishee says it takes approximately one week to build their nest, one week to lay their eggs, 18 days to hatch and 18 days to fly.

There are THREE

different kinds of bluebirds in North America, including the Eastern Bluebird (Sialia sialis), Western Bluebird, and Mountain Bluebird (Sialia currucoides). All are the same size with similar physical characteristics other than their color distribution. This is the best way to distinguish a Western Bluebird from an Eastern Bluebird. If you see a blue throat, it's a Western Bluebird, and if you see a reddishbrown throat, it's an Eastern Bluebird. While bluebird males are usually bright blue, the females are usually a little bit more muted in



color. Eastern Bluebirds eat mostly insects, wild fruit and berries. The nests they build in their boxes are stunning! So organized. Contemporary in style. Perfection. Built one piece of pine straw at a time. Take a minute to "knock" on a box and open the hinged door to view their meticulous creation. The Bluebirds are friendly and seem to almost enjoy human company. They display



no fear of nesting near human habitation and LOVE their homes at Old Waverly and Mossy Oak. By special request, they are exempt from HOA dues.



According to two different studies, 26% – 44% of adult bluebirds return to breed at the same site where they nested the previous year. Therefore, there is about a one in three chance that the bluebirds we have in our nest boxes this year will return to the same box next year. And get this,

they will probably be with their first love. Most Bluebirds (95%) mate for life and mated pairs can stay together for as long as they survive, usually 6-10 years.

To the tribesmen of the Navajo and Iroquois, the bluebirds symbolize good fortune, fertility, and prosperity. Some believe the bluebird is a symbol of joy and hope; others, that good news will be arriving soon. Others still think that bluebirds represent a connection between the living and those who have passed.

> What we do know for sure is the Eastern Bluebirds are thriving at Old Waverly and Mossy Oak thanks to Mr. Jerry Ishee. Another thing we know for sure is they are leaving soon. Migrating to Mexico or West Texas is a good guess. Mr. Ishee anticipates he will make one more round this year to check on all of his boxes.

As Spring and Summer relents to the cooler days of Fall and Winter, we will appreciate the Seasons and rest in knowing that Spring will return...and so too will the Bluebirds.

WINE OF THE MONTHS

Chalk Hill Chardonnay for September and Belle Glos Alturas for October

With the Fall season beginning shortly heralding in bright Fall colors and best of all, Fall Football, it is only in keeping with Old Waverly hospitality to pour some very special wines. For **SEPTEMBER WINE OF THE MONTH**, I have chosen the rich and buttery **CHALK HILL CHARDONNAY** from



the fabulous SONOMA COAST AVA 2017 of California wine country. A Rob Foley family wine it is Complex with apple, pear, vanilla finishing in oak and creme, this fine wine matches well with pork loin, grilled and baked shrimp, lobster, and most any white meat or fish grilled and baked. Try by the glass in September for just \$7.50.

As for **OCTOBER WINE OF THE MONTH** the familiar **BELL GLOS ALTURUS VINEYARD PINOT NOIR 2022** from the SANTA LUCIA HIGHLANDS of California's Central Coast region was an obvious choice. Made by Joseph Wagner, son of Robert Wagner of the famous



cabernet house of Caymus, this gorgeous pinot grown on the highest hills (many consider it the richest and best of the Bell Glos series of pinot noirs), it is heady and opulent with notes of bright cherries, plums, and bittersweet chocolate marked with graphite and some sandy loam. You may also find a touch of black raspberry, red currants, minerality and leather finishes. Try with any of chef's mushroom fare, rack of lamb, beef tenderloin, grilled or baked salmon or grilled rare tuna. I will be good with almost anything. By the glass only in October for \$8.50. NO SPOOKING!


